Goulburn Street Primary are creating new habits to help make a difference to the environment! Expanding on the school community's commitment to sustainability practices we have introduced additional structures to support waste management. Each classroom now has containers enabling rubbish to be sorted for recycling, composting/worm bins, soft plastics and a very tiny bin for landfill. Students and staff have taken on the challenge, reminding and helping each other to think about how we separate and dispose of waste. Already we have significantly reduced the daily amount of rubbish that goes to landfill.

School Times and Absences—Lessons begin at 9:00am with a teacher commencing duty outside and classroom doors opening at 8:30am. This allows time for students to set up for the first session and to greet teachers before heading outside to play with friends until the morning bell signals the start of school.

The school day ends at 3:00pm. If a student has not been collected by a family member by 3:10pm the class or duty teacher will accompany them to the office from where parents will be contacted. Parents are responsible for their child outside school hours unless they are booked with Lady Gowrie in the afternoon. If using school grounds out of hours it is important to play safely and to be mindful of noise levels as staff members are working nearby.

Schools are required to follow up on unexplained absences and we greatly appreciate notification of absences, by email, through our new website or with a phone call on the day to assist us in monitoring attendance. In addition if your child has an appointment, and is therefore late arriving or has an early departure, we require the adult carer to sign the child in or out at the office.

**Information Session and Sausage Sizzle** — An Information Session for parents and carers will be held on Wednesday 21st February. Teachers will each have two rostered times for parents/carers to visit classrooms. This is an opportunity to gain an overall understanding of classroom programs and expectations as well as ways you might be able to support your child's learning and wellbeing over the year.

The Information Session is about providing general information to parents/ carers in group situations. Early in Term Two Parent/Teacher Conversations are scheduled, providing the opportunity for teachers and parents to share specific information about your child's progress and wellbeing. We welcome news from home that will help us support your child and often casual catchups with teachers are possible at drop off and pick up times. For more indepth conversations parents are encouraged to arrange a time to meet with a teacher of myself and this can be done throughout the year.

Members of the School Association are organising a sausage sizzle to coincide with the Information Session, as a way of enabling parents and friends to meet and mingle. The barbecue will be set up in the courtyard between 3:15-5:00pm and payment can be made on the day. An order form to assist with catering can be found within the newsletter beneath the roster for the Information Session. We hope to have many families participate in the Information Session and Sausage Sizzle.
